## **COMPLAINT**

NOW COMES Plaintiff, CHICAGO PUBLIC MEDIA, by its undersigned attorneys, LOEVY & LOEVY, and brings this suit to overturn Defendant COOK COUNTY OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT's refusal, in willful violation of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, to comply with CHICAGO PUBLIC MEDIA's Freedom of Information Act requests for Cook County Commissioner Bridget Gainer's county emails regarding her political action committee. In support of its Complaint, CHICAGO PUBLIC MEDIA states as follows:

## INTRODUCTION

- 1. Pursuant to the fundamental philosophy of the American constitutional form of government, it is the public policy of the State of Illinois that all persons are entitled to full and complete information regarding the affairs of government and the official acts and policies of those who represent them as public officials and public employees consistent with the terms of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). 5 ILCS 140/1.
- 2. Restraints on access to information, to the extent permitted by FOIA, are limited exceptions to the principle that the people of this state have a right to full disclosure of information relating to the decisions, policies, procedures, rules, standards, and other aspects of

government activity that affect the conduct of government and the lives of the people. 5 ILCS 140/1.

- 3. All public records of a public body are presumed to be open to inspection or copying. Any public body that asserts that a record is exempt from disclosure has the burden of proving by clear and convincing evidence that it is exempt. 5 ILCS 140/3.
- 4. Under FOIA Section 11(h), "except as to causes the court considers to be of greater importance, proceedings arising under [FOIA] shall take precedence on the docket over all other causes and be assigned for hearing and trial at the earliest practicable date and expedited in every way."

#### **PARTIES**

- 5. Plaintiff CHICAGO PUBLIC MEDIA ("CPM") is the FOIA requester in this case. CHICAGO PUBLIC MEDIA serves the public interest by creating and delivering diverse, compelling content that informs, inspires, enriches and entertains. Through a broad range of media platforms—such as the nonprofit radio station WBEZ 91.5fm—it connects diverse audiences in its service area and beyond to one another. It helps them make a difference in our communities, our region, and our world.
- 6. Defendant COOK COUNTY OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT ("CCOP") is a public body located in Cook County, Illinois.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

- 7. Cause the Effect Chicago PAC is a registered political action committee with the Illinois State Board of Elections. A true and correct copy of the Statement of Organization is attached as Exhibit A.
- 8. Cook County Commissioner Bridget Gainer was the Chairman of Cause the Effect Chicago PAC.

- 9. Katie Sabo, a former employee of the Cook County Board of Commissioners and aide to Gainer, was the Treasurer of Cause the Effect Chicago PAC.
- 10. Cause the Effect Chicago PAC was formerly known as "Off the Sidelines Chicago."

# **JULY 20, 2018 FOIA REQUEST**

- 11. On July 20, 2018, CPM requested "any and all correspondences, written or electronic, that contain the key words 'Cause the Effect' or 'Off the Sidelines' and were sent by Cook County Commissioner Bridget Gainer or any of the following employees of the Cook County Board of Commissioners: Margaret Cox, Katie Sabo, Abin Kuriakose, Michaela Vargas, Marty Malone." A true and correct copy of the request is attached as Exhibit B.
- 12. On July 31, 2018, CCOP responded to the FOIA request by asking for an extension to August 3, 2018, stating that the request was unduly burdensome, and asking CPM to agree to narrow the request. A true and correct copy of the response is attached as Exhibit C.
- 13. On August 2, 2018, CPM agreed to narrow the request to only search for records from January 1, 2015 to the present.
- 14. On August 3, 2018, CCOP told CPM that the County Information and Technology Department has identified approximately 88 records and that Commissioner Gainer has identified approximately 3,000 records.
- 15. On August 10, 2018, CCOP produced 88 responsive records subject to redactions based on FOIA Sections 7(1)(b), 7(1)(c), 2(c-5), and 7(1)(f). A true and correct copy of the response is attached as Exhibit D.
- 16. None of the 3,000 emails that Commissioner Gainer identified were not produced on August 10, and CCOP has not provided a proper denial of that portion of the request.

## **AUGUST 1, 2018 FOIA REQUEST**

- 17. On August 1, 2018, CPM requested "any and all correspondences written or electronic, between the Office of the President or its employees and Cook County Commissioner Bridget Gainer or her staff since July 19, 2018 regarding [Dan Mihalopoulos's] Freedom of Information Act request to the Office of the President file on July 20, 2018." A true and correct copy of the response is attached as Exhibit E.
- 18. On August 9, 2018, CCOP produced nine responsive email records subject to redactions based on FOIA Sections 7(1)(b), 7(1)(c), 2(c-5), 7(1)(a), and 7(1)(m). A true and correct copy of the response is attached as Exhibit F.

## COUNT I – JULY 20, 2018 FAILURE TO PRODUCE RECORDS

- 19. The above paragraphs are incorporated by reference.
- 20. CCOP is a public body under FOIA.
- 21. The records sought in CPM's FOIA request are non-exempt public records of CCOP.
- 22. CCOP violated FOIA by failing to produce all of the responsive records to CPM's FOIA request and by improperly redacting the records that were produced.

#### COUNT II – JULY 20, 2018 WILLFUL AND INTENTIONAL VIOLATION OF FOIA

- 23. The above paragraphs are incorporated by reference.
- 24. CCOP is a public body under FOIA.
- 25. The records sought in CPM's FOIA request are non-exempt public records of CCOP.
- 26. CCOP willfully and intentionally, or otherwise in bad faith failed to comply with FOIA.

# COUNT III – AUGUST 1, 2018 FAILURE TO PRODUCE RECORDS

- 27. The above paragraphs are incorporated by reference.
- 28. CCOP is a public body under FOIA.
- 29. The records sought in CPM's FOIA request are non-exempt public records of CCOP.
  - 30. CCOP violated FOIA by improperly redacting the records that were produced.

## COUNT IV - AUGUST 1, 2018 WILLFUL AND INTENTIONAL VIOLATION OF FOIA

- 31. The above paragraphs are incorporated by reference.
- 32. CCOP is a public body under FOIA.
- 33. The records sought in CPM's FOIA request are non-exempt public records of CCOP.
- 34. CCOP willfully and intentionally, or otherwise in bad faith failed to comply with FOIA.

# WHEREFORE, CPM asks that the Court:

- in accordance with FOIA Section 11(f), afford this case precedence on the Court's docket except as to causes the Court considers to be of greater importance, assign this case for hearing and trial at the earliest practicable date, and expedite this case in every way;
- ii. declare that CCOP has violated FOIA;
- iii. order CCOP to produce the requested records;
- iv. enjoin CCOP from withholding non-exempt public records under FOIA;
- v. order CCOP to pay civil penalties;
- vi. award Plaintiff reasonable attorneys' fees and costs;

vii. award such other relief the Court considers appropriate.

The Office of the President of the Cook County Board of Commissioners is in receipt of your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (the "Act").

On Friday, July 20, 2018 you requested "any and all correspondences, written or electronic, that contain the key words 'Cause the Effect' or 'Off the Sidelines' and were sent by Cook County Commissioner Bridget Gainer or any of the following employees of the Cook County Board of Commissioners:

- Katie Sabo

Pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/3(e)(vii), we extended the deadline to respond to your request, up to and including Friday, August 3, 2018.

On July 31, 2018 you were informed that your request was unduly burdensome and that compliance with your request could not be completed without interfering with the daily operations of Cook County government. In accordance with section 3(g) of the Act, we discussed by phone on August 2, 2018 narrowing the requested information.

On August 2, 2018 you provided an initial narrow of your request by maintaining the substantive nature of your request but narrowing the time frame for records sent since January, 2015. Per our conversation on August, 3, 2018, we discussed two separate tracks of documents; documents that could be generated by the County's Enterprise Technology Department and documents that were directly in the possession of the Commissioner's Office. We agreed by phone on August 3, 2018 that the County would work with the Commissioner's Office to begin to review the records identified by the County Information Technology Department for responsiveness and apply any necessary redactions; furthermore, you were informed on August 3<sup>rd</sup> that said County records would be tendered on or before August 10, 2018.

Attached are the County email records responsive to this request that could be generated by the County's Enterprise Technology Department. Due to the size of the attachments the attachments will be separated into two emails. Please note the following:

- Private E-mail addresses and private cell phones have been redacted pursuant to sections 7(1)(b) and 1(c) of the Act. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b); 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c) and 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5).
- Preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated have been redacted pursuant to sections 7(1)(f) of the Act. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f)

The undersigned is responsible for this partial denial. You have a right to have the partial denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a hard copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.

As to the remainder of documents in the Commissioner's possession, per our agreement on August 3, 2018, the County asked Commissioner Gainer's Office to (a) determine if the records in her possession could be further broken down by name and year so we could confer at a later date and determine how the request can be further narrowed and (b) determine if a log could be easily printed that would provide the date, sender, recipient and subject of the communication; please note, if such a log can be generated, the County would have to review the log and determine if redactions were required.

Commissioner Gainer's Office has advised that they are working on a log and I anticipate being in touch with you next week regarding the status of such log. It is anticipated that we will confer again following receipt and review of the log.

Thanks for your patience while we continue to work on responding to your request.
