I might note parenthetically that the dissenting opinion by Chief Justice Burger has a sound, hard-core defense of the right to free expression that has been so badly trampled by Congress and now the Supreme Court.

I am pleased, however, that we received a favorable decision on our Advisory Opinion request and that the limits on individual expenditures no longer exist.
