Enclosed is most of the manuscript for Roger's upcoming book. We're exposing it to publishers in New York for the first time this week and should have an idea before long as to whether or not we can get a good publisher. There is still some work to be done and a little re-writing of the chapters as they now stand but on the whole I think it's really an outstanding effort and it does fill a void in the literature of libertarianism. Hoppers tends to be too anecdotal and Murray can be too doctrinaire whereas Roger's style presents the radicalism of our philosophy in a manner that is understandable and palatable to the average person.

We have not yet heard anything regarding our request for an advisory opinion although the Supreme Court decision is due within a week or two (how many times have I said that?).
