**ORDER GRANTING PLEA TO THE JURISDICTION AND MOTION TO DISMISS

The Court considered the State's Plea to the Jurisdiction and Defendant Blue Ridge Landfill, LP's Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction. After considering the motions, response, and the arguments of counsel, the Court concludes that the Plea to the Jurisdiction and the Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction should be GRANTED.
