As Graves was pulling up to the shop, both the male and female attempted to go back into the shop. Graves advised both subjects to stop and Graves approached them. Graves separated both subjects. Deputy Struve and Trooper Womack spoke with the female while Graves spoke with the male. While Graves was inquiring about the assault, he also inquired if there were any other adults or children present during the assault. The male stated, "Yes all four of my kids are inside." Deputy Struve and Trooper Womack conducted a warrant check on both subjects and discovered a CPS Child Safety Check Alert on their identification returns.



The source of interior heating were unsafe space heaters that were within easy reach of the children and against where the children were sleeping. The children's clothes and bedding were dirty and the children who were in diapers had dirty diapers that appeared to not have been changed in a lengthy amount of time. Food was located inside the residence, however; the refrigerator and pantry were

secured where children were unable to access any of the food and appeared to be malnourished.


