

Affidavit of Probable Cause

Probable Cause belief is based upon the following facts and circumstances:

Your Affiant, Chief George McClay, Badge #316 of the Morrisville Borough Police Department, has been duly sworn/appointed/employed as a police officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 1986. Your Co-affiant, Detective Martin McDonough Badge #9916, of the Bucks County District Attorney's office, Bucks County, PA has been duly sworn/appointed/employed as a police officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 1987. Your Co-Affiant, Detective David Coyne, Badge #9926, of the Bucks County District Attorney's Office, Bucks County, PA, has been duly sworn/appointed/employed as a police officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 1992. Your Affiants are certified as a Police Officers in Pennsylvania and are authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in all criminal cases.

On Monday, February 25, 2019, Bucks County Children and Youth representatives responded to 200 West Bridget Street, Apartment S7, Morrisville, Bucks County, PA 19067 for an unannounced visit at 1600. There was no response when Bucks County Caseworker Valerie Egley knocked at the apartment door. Egley had an apartment complex maintenance worker, Bud Miller, check the apartment for a well-being check. Eight individuals, including multiple children were known to have lived in the apartment, according to Ms. Egley.

At 1616 hours Miller the maintenance worker, call Bucks County Emergency Communications. Miller reported two individuals in bcd in Apartment S7 seemed disoriented and the apartment was in disarray. Morrisville Police were dispatched to the scene. Morrisville Police Officer Bo Luna was the first on scene at 1617 hours. At 1623 Cpl Christopher Mcintyre requested to expedite two emergency squads for the disoriented individuals. Those two females, later identified as Shana Decree and Dominique Decree, were transported from the scene to the hospital.

On February 25, 2019 at 1740 hours, Morrisville Police Chief George McClay, Officer Luna, Bucks County Detectives Martin McDonough, Dale Keddie and David Coyne entered apartment S7. The apartment was in disarray, with furniture turned over

and with broken glass and clutter throughout. Egley told law enforcement the apartment was not in disarray on February 5, 2019, when she was last inside.

Police found an unoccupied bedroom on the left and an unoccupied bedroom at the end of the hall on the right. Behind the last door on the left was a bedroom. Inside police initially found four bodies. A black male was on the bed face up with his head toward the foot of the bed and his right foot through the wall into the adjacent bedroom. A female was on floor face up at the foot of the bed with her head toward the door. Another female was located to the left of the bed toward the foot of the bed in a seated position against the bed. A female child was lying on the floor to left of the bed face up and head toward the foot of the bed. A fifth body, a female, was later found under one of the bodies next to the bed. They were later identified by Shana Decree as Naa' Irah Smith, age 25; age 13; Jamilla Campbell, age 42; and and and nine-year-old twins

Chief Christopher McAteer and Lieutenant David Kemmerer, Bucks County District Attorney's Office, spoke with Dominique Decree and Shana Decree at Jefferson Bucks Hospital emergency room. Each was read her right pursuant to Miranda, and each waived those rights and agreed to speak to police without an attorney present.

Dominique Decree, who was in exam room #8 and had visible injuries to her neck, at first denied knowing what had occurred. She advised she lived at her residence with her mother Shana Decree; her sister, Naa'Irah Smith; her brother, ther aunt, Jamilla Campbell; and her aunt Jamilla Campbell's twin daughters, and Dominique at first claimed an unknown back male caused the injuries to her neck, denied knowing what happened, and asked if her family was alive. She also repeatedly advised her wish to die.

Shana Decree was in exam room 16. She also at first denied knowing what occurred. Shana then advised that Jamilla's boyfriend, Secree Allen, and two unknown males came into the apartment and killed everyone, except her and Dominique.

Dominque, after being advised she should not be afraid to name who committed the crimes at the apartment, and after being told that her mother identified who did it, told police a male named Secree did it with two other black males.

Shana later told police that everyone at the apartment, including the nine-year-olds and the thirteen-year-old, wanted to die. Shana advised that all, including the children, were talking about suicide. Shana advised she had killed that, that Jamila Campbell killed that, that Campbell killed that and Dominique Decree both killed that; and that Dominique Decree killed Jamila Campbell.

Dominique Decree then told Kemmerer and McAteer that Shana Decree killed , , and Naa'Irah Smith; that Jamila Campbell choked , to death; and that she choked Jamila Campbell to death.

Your Affiant certifies that this filing complies with the provisions of the Case Records Public Access Policy of the Unified Judicial System of Pennsylvania that require filing confidential information and documents differently than non-confidential information and documents.

Based on the statements and the other facts gleaned during this investigation, your affiants respectfully request an arrest warrant be issued for Dominique Decree charging her with the following crimes:
