

On 03/02/2019, at approximately 1618 hours, off duty Officer R. Shriver observed a person known to him as Albert Mazon in the Safeway parking lot driving a gold colored Honda. Ofc. Shriver called on duty Officer Vaughan to confirm Mazon had an outstanding Parole Warrant for his arrest. Ofc. Shriver then followed Mazon to the Fred Meyers parking lot. Ofc. Shriver kept

13 Officer Vaughan responded to the Fred Meyers parking lot and attempted to contact Mazon and
14 arrest him on the outstanding warrant. Mazon was still inside Alaska License DVZ307, a 2000
15 gold Honda Accord.

16
17 The next transmission I heard on the JPD radio was Ofc. Vaughan requesting a medical unit as
18 Mazon just tried to run over him with his vehicle, he got hit by the car, and Mazon got tased.

19
20
21 I spoke to Ofc. Shriver and asked him what happened. He walked me through the scene and
22 described what happened. He showed me the parking spot in which Mazon was parked.

23 Ofc. Shriver said Ofc. Vaughan approached the vehicle on the driver's side and contacted Mazon
24 who was in the driver's seat and told him had warrants and to exit the vehicle. Ofc. Vaughan
25 then opened the driver's door. At the same time, Ofc. Shriver saw the reverse lights come on
26 and the vehicle began to rapidly go backwards. Ofc. Vaughan was trapped in the open driver's
27 door as it backed up. He grabbed onto Mazon and held on as he was being dragged under the

vehicle. As Ofc. Vaughan was being dragged, he was tolling Mazon to,"Stop. You're going to kill me." The vehicle continued backwards through the parking lot and over a curbed landscaped area with shrubs. Once the vehicle was on the opposite side of the landscaped area, it stopped momentarily to change direction. This allowed Ofc. Vaughan time to disengage and roll away from the vehicle. The vehicle then accelerated rapidly forward. The vehicle lost control, swerved to the left, and drove up a snow bank. Ofc. Vaughan regained his footing and approached the now closed driver's door. He used his baton to break the driver's window in order to access Mazon, but Mazon switched seats and ran out the passenger's side front door. Ofc. Shriver chased Mazon and grabbed onto him when he tripped and fell to the ground. Ofc. Vaughan caught up and ultimately applied the Taser to Mazon before he was controlled and placed into wrist restraints.

I could see tears to the right pant leg of Ofc. Vaughan who complained of pain to his right leg from being dragged by Mazon. I observed a bruise beginning to become visible on Ofc. Shriver's right hand. Ofc. Shriver complained of pain in the right hand from attempting to subdue Mazon.
