These individuals are concerned by the Australian Government's consideration of sites for a nuclear waste repository, to contain a range of wastes including wastes that are due to be returned from the UK. These wastes from the UK arise from past fuel reprocessing carried out under international contract at Dounreay. Under the joint Scottish Government/ UK Government waste substation policy, the waste will be returned to Australian in the form of vitrified waste from Sellafied, which the Australian Government is better able to handle and store. The substitution policy has no bearing on the fact that waste is due to be returned, nor on any decision of the Australian Government as to where to store this and other wastes under their control.
