Homicide: 2700 Block of Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue, Southeast

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department's Homicide Branch are investigating a homicide that occurred on Sunday, May 26, 2019, in the 2700 block of Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue, Southeast.

At approximately 5:40 pm, members of the Seventh District responded to the listed location for the report of a stabbing. Upon arrival, members located an unconscious adult male victim, suffering from laceration wounds. DC Fire and Emergency Medical Services responded to the scene and transported the victim to a local hospital. After all lifesaving efforts failed, the victim was pronounced dead.

The decedent has been identified as 44 year-old Michael Hooker, of Southeast, DC.

The Metropolitan Police Department currently offers a reward of up to **\$25,000** to anyone that provides information which leads to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for any homicide committed in the District of Columbia.
