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The Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) United States Border Patrol (USBP) conducts daily border security operations in Federal public lands that fall under the oversight of the Department of Interior (DOI). These lands include, but are not limited to, National Parks, National Monuments, Wildlife Refuges, and National Recreational Areas that are located across the southern border. The sectors with border zones in these public lands routinely conduct joint operations with the respective DOI Law Enforcement Officers (LEOs) to prevent, detect, and resolve cross border traffic. These actions not only serve to protect the American people from terrorists and transnational criminal organizations, but also protect these Federal lands and the natural and cultural resources from damages caused by cross border traffic.
