17/18 – 18/19 Increased Live Class Student Attendance

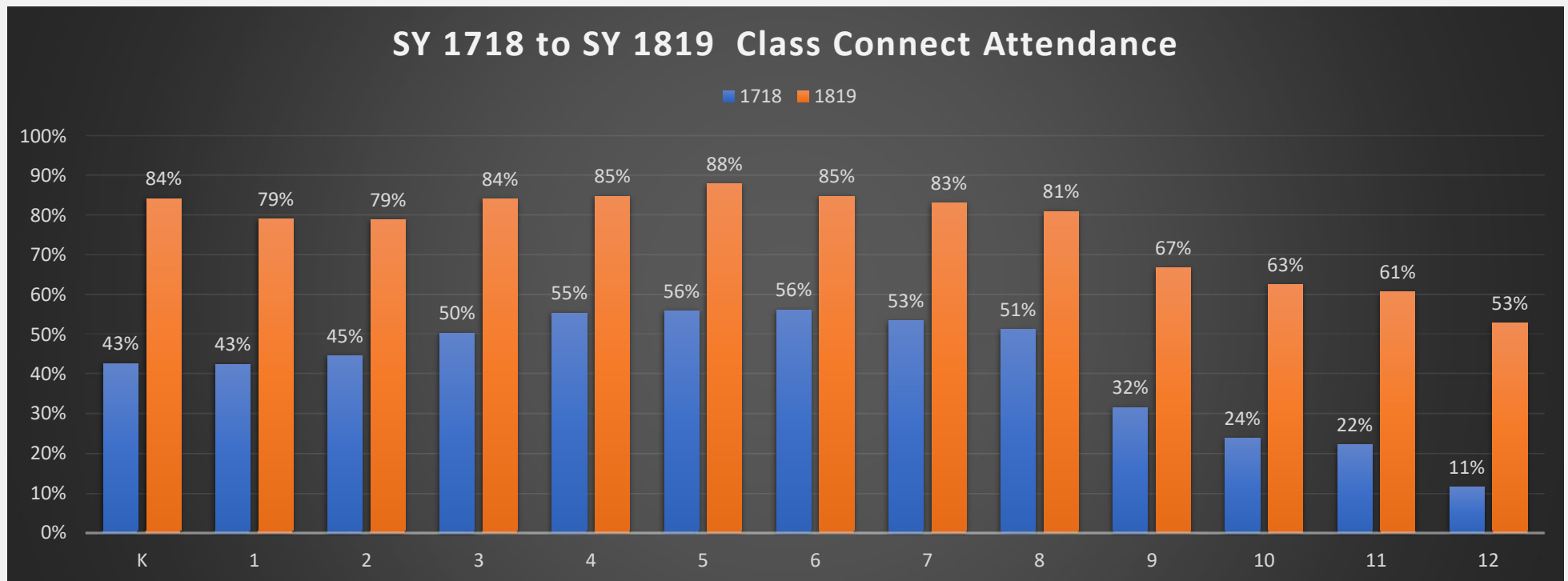


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Year over Year Live Class Attendance Comparison
