Homicide: 4200 Block of 7th Street, Southeast

Friday, July 5, 2019

Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department's Homicide Branch are investigating a fatal shooting that occurred on Thursday, July 4, 2019, in the 4200 block of 7th Street, Southeast.

At approximately 11:07 pm, members of the Seventh District responded to the listed location for the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, members located an adult male victim suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. DC Fire and Emergency Medical Services responded to the scene and transported the victim to an area hospital. After all lifesaving efforts failed, the victim was pronounced dead.

The decedent has been identified as **23 year-old Keonte Haynesworth**, of Upper Marlboro, MD.

The Metropolitan Police Department currently offers a reward of up to **\$25,000** to anyone that provides information which leads to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for any homicide committed in the District of Columbia. Anyone with information about this case is asked to call the police at **202-727-9099**. Additionally, anonymous information may be submitted to the department's **TEXT TIP LINE** by sending a text message to **50411**.
