On 09/02/2013 at approximately 2002 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Punta Gorda, Charlotte County, Florida in reference to a public assist call.

Upon arrival, I made contact with [REDACTED] who advised that her son, Thomas M. Mcvicker ([REDACTED]), has been

living with her and her husband, [redacted] for approximately two weeks. [redacted] told me that Thomas has been displaying abnormal behavior; has been drinking, and she wanted him Baker Acted. [redacted] said that Thomas has been acting weird lately and she believes he has it out for her. [redacted] told me that she believes Thomas has a mental disorder but he will not go get checked out. I asked [redacted] how she believed Thomas has been acting weird. [redacted] gave me examples such as: putting towels over the bird cages because they gave him headaches and he thought they were a demon; he would follow her around and touch himself in his privates, and his eyes would roll back. [redacted] further advised that Thomas mentioned something along the lines of, "maybe it would just be easier if he was dead". [redacted] told me that she could not handle it anymore and that she called Thomas a cab so he could go to the Holiday Inn and get out of the house.

I responded to the Holiday Inn and made contact with Thomas, who was walking back from the 7-11. I advised Thomas that he was not in any trouble and that his parents were concerned about him. Thomas told me that he and his mom have a different opinion about things and that he just wanted to get out of the house for a while to clear his head and relax, so he is staying at the hotel for two days. Thomas told me that he never said that it would just be easier if he was dead, and that his mom is making stuff up. Thomas assured me that he did not want to harm himself or anybody else. But, he just wanted to get away from his mom for a couple days.

While speaking with Thomas, he did not appear intoxicated and was in good health.

I contacted [redacted] via phone, and advised her that Thomas did not meet the criteria for a Baker Act. [redacted] told me that she believes Thomas is putting on a good show. I suggested to [redacted] to contact CCSO tomorrow and that we can do a well-being check on him. [redacted] agreed.

No further action required.

Upon arrival to the area I located the subject based on the description in the call. I made contact with the person, w/m Thomas M. McVicker [REDACTED]. Thomas advised he lives in the area and went for a walk to get some fresh air. Thomas was very cooperative

but seemed to be having some sort of mental issues. I evaluated Thomas for a Baker act and determined he did not meet the criteria, however when I asked Thomas if he would like to talk to a professional in order to work out his issues, he advised he would. I had dispatch run Thomas in NCIC/FCIC which had negative results. I searched Thomas for any weapons or illegal items as he gave consent and did not locate any contraband. I transported Thomas to CSU located on Education Drive in Punta Gorda without incident.

I made contact with the caller, w/ [redacted] [redacted] explained Thomas was acting strange as he was standing in the same area for long period of time. I explained to [redacted] I was able to assist Thomas and that he did not appear to be a danger to anyone. No further assistance required.
