






#### West Virginians less optimistic about the economy than the Nation as a whole

# Hiring workers who can pass a drug test is considered a major barrier by 59% of registered voters




Net Barrier = 87%

#### Nearly 40% of voters believe getting workers to show up daily is a major barrier




Net Barrier = 78%
