





Acting on the information received, affiant conducted the following independent investigation:

Detective conducted surveillance at the above location on October 5 around 1700 hrs. Detectives observed a plump female leave the porch of 1922 W Chestnut and enter the residence of 1920 W Chestnut St. A short time later a vehicle pulled up and parked. A Black male went to 1920 W Chestnut and was immediately let in the door by the same female. The male stayed approximately 10 minutes then left. Detective then approached the house to conduct a knock and talk. As Detectives approached and stepped onto the open porch, the smell of fresh marijuana could be smelled. As Affiant stepped in front of the main door the odor grew stronger and was obvious coming from within the house. Affiant knocked, and no one answered.

On October 22 detective conducted surveillance at the above location a gray Jaguar parked in front of the house and a black male got out and entered the residence. The Jaguar had a Indiana license plate of 555BO. Detective ran the license plate through NCIC and learned the registered owner was a Mario Daugherty,

On October 23 approximately 0530 hrs. detective approached the house and again was hit with a strong smell of fresh marijuana coming from within the house.

Based on the narcotics metro complaint, the witness of a short stay, the strong fresh smell of marijuana on separate occasions and detectives training and experience, Affiant believes there is illegal drugs being used/and or stored in this residence.
