Arrest Made in a Homicide: 3500 Block of 22nd Street, Southeast

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department's Homicide Branch have announced an arrest has been made in a homicide that occurred on Wednesday, June 5, 2019, in the 3500 block of 22nd Street, Southeast.

At approximately 8:21 pm, members of the Seventh District responded to the listed location for the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, members located an adult male victim, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. DC Fire and Emergency Medical Services responded to the scene and transported the victim to an area hospital. After all life-saving efforts failed, the victim was pronounced dead. Additionally, a juvenile male victim arrived at local hospital suffering from a gunshot wound. He was treated for non-life threatening injuries.

The decedent has been identified as **39 year-old Bruce Gilmore** of Southeast, DC.

On Friday, November 22, 2019, pursuant to a DC Superior Court arrest warrant, **19 year-old Terrance Prue**, of Southeast, DC, was arrested by members of the Capital Area Regional Fugitive Task Force (CARFTF) and charged with **First Degree Murder while Armed**.
