
Snapshot of Ohio Pregnancy-Associated Deaths, 2008-2016

From 2008 through 2016 there were 610 pregnancy-associated deaths in Ohio 70% (n=428) occurred in the postpartum period, up to 1 year after pregnancy 31% (n=131) of those occurred within 6 weeks of pregnancy

31% (n=186) were determined to be pregnancy-related.

 The most common cause of death was cardiovascular and coronary conditions 16% 60% (n=368)
were determined to be pregnancy-associated, but not pregnancy-related.

 The most common cause of death was unintentional injury 45%



Pregnancy-associated death:

The death of a woman while pregnant or anytime within one year of pregnancy regardless of cause.

Pregnancyrelated death:

The death of a woman while pregnant or within one year of pregnancy from any cause related to or aggravated by the pregnancy or management, excluding accidental or incidental causes.

Pregnancyassociated, but
not pregnancyrelated death:
The death of a woman
while pregnant or within
one year of pregnancy,
due to a cause unrelated
to pregnancy.

Could not determine:

The death of a woman while pregnant or within one year of pregnancy, due to a cause that could not be determined to be pregnancy-related or not pregnancy-related.
