The 2019 BAGS sponsored Kennelhand of the Year is Hannah Prince, Head Kennelhand to Gerry Ballentine, Perry Barr.

This prestigious award is presented to one outstanding kennelhand who shows impressive commitment to their work and who goes above and beyond to provide the highest standards of care to the greyhounds in their charge.

Hannah's dedication and enthusiasm were showcased in her nominations which praised the young kennelhand for her tireless efforts, professionalism and inspiring work ethic. With both parents having been involved in training at Monmore, Hannah has been around

They were particularly impressed by Hannah's nomination from the Racing Office at Perry Barr which outlines her far-reaching, positive impact beyond the kennels.

Nominations commended Hannah for the devotion she shows to her greyhounds, who are the subject of many heartfelt posts on her social media. Comments included:

"Hannah spends all her working hours tending to the needs of the greyhounds under her care at Gerry's kennel. GBGB GRADED GREYHOUND OF THE YEAR 2019 - THESE OLD SHADES

THESE OLD SHADES, trained at Sheffield by Barrie Draper, is the GBGB Graded Greyhound of the Year for 2019.

Owned by David, Jean and Ben Tompkins, the British-bred August 16 daughter of Confident Rankin and Farloe Lila impressed the GBGB judging panel with her performances during the year, not least her versatility.

Mat Stagg, deputy racing manager at the Owlerton circuit, said: "These Old Shades has proven one of the most versatile greyhounds we have on the strength, winning races, and producing top-class performances over both four and six bends.

"She's been a real credit to Barrie Draper and his team, a fantastic bitch, who won 16 races at Sheffield in 2019 ranging from A5-A3 and plenty of handicaps in between over both 500m and 660m - and that's been the impressive thing about her.

"She's taken both distances in her stride, literally, and showed really good trackcraft in every race she has - which is a great strength in handicaps. She's usually having to come from the back off the scratch mark to take the lead - just at the right time!"

Rose Draper, the trainer's daughter and assistant – a Greyhound Ambassador and regular on RPGTV - said the three-year-old thoroughly deserved the honour and the announcement has added to a special year for her owners.

Rose Draper said: "These Old Shades, or 'Susan' as she's known at the kennel, is their first greyhound and has been brilliant for David, Jean, Ben and all the family. They've been involved in horse racing before, but Susan was their first greyhound!

"They got her at 12 weeks old and never expected her to become the kennel superstar she is. Susan's a lovely, big bitch whose attitude is all about winning - she never knows when she's beaten and puts her entire heart into it.

"I know she has a home for life with her owners after racing but is still very much on the strength at Sheffield. After a short break, she ran in an A3 last week and probably needed the run. She's due to line up in an A4 on Tuesday and I'm sure will be winning again soon."

Dave Perry, venue director at Sheffield, said: "Well done to the connections of These Old Shades - trainer Barrie Draper and the Tompkins family, her owners. They had a superb year with her - and I know she's become a very popular greyhound here."

These Old Shades won 16 races from 38 starts in 2019 for a 42.1 per cent strike-rate - winning over both 500m and 660m in handicap company as well as level-start 500m races in A5, A4 and A3.

The GBGB panel, while delighted to acknowledge the performances of These Old Shades last year, were also keen to recognise the efforts of runner-up Alfies Prince and third-placed Mannix Sid, who both enjoyed a fantastic 2019.

Trained at Nottingham by Barrie Denby, August 14 veteran Alfies Prince ran 29 times in 2019, winning 12 times and finishing in the frame on a number of occasions. His tally included a run of six consecutive successes in A1 and open-race company in June and July. Trained at Peterborough by David Pruhs, Mannix Sid won 11 races in 2019, including no less than nine A1s. He also celebrated his 100th race in October with victory and racked up a four-race unbeaten sequence in July.

Other runners given due credit by the GBGB judging panel were impressive veterans Monmore's Kranky Scott (Pam Burford) who celebrated his sixth birthday and 200th race in 2019 and Yarmouth's ultra-consistent Group Braveheart (Paul Burr).

BIOSECURITY, CLEANSING AND DISINFECTION

Biosecurity means many different things to different people depending on the situation but should be looked at from several angles. Biosecurity involves the day-to-day cleanliness of a kennels, whilst cleansing and disinfection describes the aggressive procedures that need to be followed when a contagious disease enters the kennels, somewhat akin to keeping a house clean whilst also having an occasional "Spring clean".

Biosecurity has different meaning according to what sort of premises are being protected. For example, a kennel has a different aim from a racecourse. A kennel biosecurity policy is designed to keep contagious diseases from entering, including the use of vaccinations. At a racecourse, the goal of biosecurity is to prevent the spread of contagious diseases between greyhounds, and between greyhounds and people.

The spread of disease from dog to dog is very difficult to stop without interfering with the day to day running of a kennel, so biosecurity is used to delay the build-up of infective material in the environment by removing dirt and debris that bacteria can grow in. By reducing the amount of infection in the environment then the challenge to the animals is far less.

So, the general idea of **biosecurity** is to reduce the numbers of germs in the environment to an acceptable level, whilst still operating the kennels, whereas cleansing and disinfection is designed to kill all germs so that the finished area is completely germ free. During cleansing and disinfection all normal kennel routines are suspended.

CHOICE OF DISINFECTANT

Greyhounds are very sensitive to the effects of phenolic disinfectants so products containing any derivative of phenol, chlorophenol, chlorocresol or chloroxylenol must be avoided (e.g. Jeyes Fluid).

The GBGB recommends the use of Anigene (formerly Trigene and Distel) or Virkon.

ROUTINE PROCEDURES

Hand washing is an important procedure for reducing the number of pathogens, because aside from direct dog to dog contact, the hands are the principal vehicle for the transmission of infection. Hand washing with plain soaps or detergents suspends microorganisms and allows them to be rinsed off; hand washing with antimicrobial-containing products kills or inhibits the growth of bacteria.

Protective clothing is a physical barrier to infection which can be easily replaced. Boiler suits and rubber boots are the simplest. Dirty overalls can be washed at 60°C after removing any obvious soiling. Attention should be paid to the grips on the boot soles where matter can be trapped.

Decontamination. Before disinfection, contaminated surfaces should be cleaned. Tables, floors, cages, walls, and doors should be physically cleaned of obvious matter. They can either be scraped when dry or wetted first to loosen hardened matter. Small hand-held steam cleaners are available for stubborn areas.

Disinfection of floors and surfaces, as well as of the utensils and bowls in daily use, are the basis in the reducing the amount of germs in the environment, and this will decrease the risk of disease.

A foot bath with the approved disinfectant at the entrance to the kennel block will encourage cleanliness. The solution must be changed daily as organic matter inactivates some disinfectants and can be a source of infection. An ideal method is to have a plain water bath to remove the gross soiling, then the disinfectant in a second bath. A stiff-bristle boot brush should be provided, and a nearby hose point for washing off mud.

Individual food and water bowls should be provided as these provide an easy method of disease transfer. Food bowls must be kept clean and not left in the kennels where the food and saliva may dry on the bowl. Fresh water must always be available. Shared water bowls in the paddocks should be avoided – each greyhound is supplied with a clean bowl and fresh water, to be removed when the dog is removed.

Muzzles should be washed and then dipped in a disinfectant solution after each use.

Race jackets and bedding should be washed at the hottest allowable for the material. Clean bedding should always be provided.

Isolation. All dogs with suspected infectious diseases should be kept in an isolated area of the kennel – this means a separate building with its own doors and airspace. The number of staff members entering the isolation area should be kept to a minimum, ideally being dedicated just to the care of the isolated animals. Upon entry into the isolation area, outerwear should be removed, and disposable shoe covers placed over the shoes or a footbath filled with disinfectant should be placed by the exit and used when leaving the area. New dogs brought into the kennels should be isolated in the same manner for seven days and observed for any signs of ill-health. Veterinary attention should be sought if in doubt.

Ventilation is not an obvious biosecurity feature, but in the unfortunate instance of a respiratory disease entering the kennel, then adequate ventilation is important in removing stagnant air. Dogs kept in poorly ventilated kennels do tend to cough more due to the build-up of dusts and ammonia fumes. Note that dogs can tolerate a lower temperature than humans provided there is no draft at floor level. In general terms, the flow should be 16 air changes per hour in the Summer and 4-8 changes per hour in the Winter.

High risk areas (including vans) where groups of dogs congregate in small areas are ideal for spreading disease. For this reason, vans should be included in the routine disinfection procedure.

CLEANSING AND DISINFECTION

This is the aggressive Spring clean referred to earlier. It is very labour intensive and is reserved for instances where disease has entered a kennels, or where low-grade disease cannot be resolved. The effort required for a proper cleansing and disinfection (sometimes called deep cleaning) is reduced when the routine biosecurity procedures are used, since the kennels will already be clean. Vehicles used for transporting greyhounds will also need to be included.

The dogs will need to be moved out of the kennels to a secure area.

Protective clothing and observance of health and safety regulations is very important due to the hazards of pressure washing and disinfectant spraying in enclosed spaces.

Cleansing and disinfection are broken down into several stages:

- 1. Removal of bedding (for burning), temporary dividers, cages, tables and equipment, and the emptying of food stores so that the inaccessible areas can be reached. Cabinets and food stores not fixed down will also need to be removed for cleaning.
- 2. Removal of gross soiling, grease and hair, high level dust and cobwebs from all surfaces including the items removed in step 1.
- 3. Pressure washing, preferably with a steam cleaner. All organic debris must be removed at this stage to avoid concealing and protecting any germs. Putty knives and small brushes are very useful here. Take care with electrical fixings to avoid water ingress, or better still turn off the power and seek professional advice on protecting the electrics. Remember to clean the outside walls and concrete areas, and the removed items from step 1.
- 4. An approved disinfectant made up to the correct dilution is then sprayed onto all surfaces. This must be allowed to dry.
- 5. Repairs can be made at this time, including the sealing of concrete and brickwork. Any new materials should be impervious.
- 6. Another application of disinfectant may be used and allowed to dry.
- 7. The removable items should also be treated, including the additional sterilization of all feeding equipment and utensils with cold sterilizing solutions.
- 8. Please ensure the same process is adopted with each van and set of travel cages used for transporting greyhounds.

Due to the amounts of water and disinfectant that are likely to be used, consideration must be given to the ways in which the dirty water will leave the premises, including the possible contamination of water supplies.

Once the disinfectant has dried, the equipment may be reinstalled, and the kennels put back into use. Record the date, and the name and amount of disinfectant used.

Cleansing and disinfection can be built into the general yearly routines for a kennel, with biosecurity procedures in use during the daily running of the kennel.

The Disciplinary Committee wish to advise those appearing before them as "the affected person" that the Disciplinary Committee has the discretion to take account of any previous breaches of the rule(s) of racing which they consider are relevant to a case being heard before them irrespective of the date of commission of the breach.

DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE INQUIRIES

The Disciplinary Committee of the GBGB were in attendance at a meeting held on 17 December 2019:-

1a Newcastle Stadium - TARGET **CHRIS - Professional Trainer** Mr AC Dawson

Professional Trainer Craig Dawson was found in breach of rules 152 (i) and (ii), 174 (i)(b), and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound TARGET CHRIS at Newcastle Stadium on 28 February 2019 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of benzoylecgonine, cocaine and m-hydroxycocaine and that he had in his charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing; and failed to use his best endeavours to ensure that the performance of the greyhound was to the satisfaction of the GRB.

1b Newcastle Stadium - PEPE **BANANAS - Professional** Trainer Mr AC Dawson

Professional Trainer Craig Dawson was found in breach of rules 152 (i) and (ii), 174 (i)(b), and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound PEPE BANANAS at Newcastle Stadium on 3 April 2019 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of benzoylecgonine, cocaine and m-hydroxycocaine and that he had in his charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing; and failed to use his best endeavours to ensure that the performance of the greyhound was to the satisfaction of the GRB.

The Above Inquiries

Mr Dawson was not in attendance but participated for part of the inquiry by telephone. Paul Twinn, racing manager of Newcastle Stadium, apologised for his non-attendance. Alex McTaggart, Stipendiary Steward, and Professor Tim Morris,

independent scientific adviser were in attendance.

On behalf of GRB, Mr Gibson said that Mr Dawson had advised GBGB that he had intended to attend the Inquiry in person, but family issues had arisen which had prevented this. He had been offered the opportunity to participate throughout the hearing by telephone but had opted only to contribute in part.

Mr Gibson said that Mr Dawson, through Alex McTaggart, had admitted the strict liability breach of rule 174(i)(b) and the GRB did not intend to pursue a breach of 174 (i) (a). Mr Gibson said he proposed that the Committee hear the two cases together. To avoid any possible prejudice of one case influencing the other, Mr Gibson said he would normally suggest the Committee hear the evidence relating to each inquiry separately and reach decisions on each. However, on this occasion he believed that there were no material differences between the two cases and so he intended to present the evidence for both cases together.

Mr Gibson stated that he believed that Mr Dawson had worked as a

Kennelhand prior to being granted a training licence in 2010 until July 2019 when he had relinquished his licence. GBGB had issued a provisional licence to Mr Dawson's wife (from whom Mr Dawson was now estranged) in order to minimise disruption to the considerable number of dogs and pups and to wind down the operation.

Mr Gibson referred to the Local Inquiry held on 11 April 2019 into the positive analysis of the urine sample taken from the greyhound TARGET CHRIS following the dog's poor performance in a 480m A5 race at Newcastle Stadium on 28 February 2019 in which the dog had finished 5th beaten by more than 15 lengths at a SP of 3/1; the urine had tested positive for cocaine and metabolites. He next referred to the Local Inquiry held on 4 July 2019 into the positive analysis of a urine sample taken from the greyhound PEPE BANANAS following a 480m qualifying trial at Newcastle which the dog failed to complete the course; the urine had tested positive for cocaine and metabolites.

At the Local Inquiry on 11 April 2019, Mr Dawson had stated that he had no idea how the drugs came to be in the greyhound, and he was not willing for himself or any of his staff to provide a hair sample for testing. Mr Dawson had stated that two 'local lads' he met at Wheatley Hill where he schooled his pups took cocaine and used the same small van to transport their dogs. The implication was that this might have been the source of the cocaine.

On 16 April 2019, Mr Dawson provided a Statement to say that at the Local Inquiry he had given evidence that he did not take any substances but now admitted he took cocaine at the weekend and had done so since October 2018 following the breakup of his marriage and to counter depression he had experienced following the death of his father and his head Kennelhand. He stated that the positive case could be due to his carelessness and cross contamination.

At the second Local Inquiry on 4 July 2019, Mr Dawson admitted that in all probability the cocaine in PEPE BANANAS came from cross-contamination from himself and he offered a plea of mitigation and outlined his plans to overcome his addiction. On 4 July 2019, Mr Dawson had been interviewed by GBGB Investigation Officer Chris Hufton in which he stated that he

used cocaine regularly (but not every night) and had done so since 2013 as he considered it necessary to his mental wellbeing due to his depression and stress.

Professor Morris gave evidence that the findings in both cases were consistent with cross-contamination from a regular user of cocaine. He advised that cocaine and benzoylecgonine were stimulants of the nervous system and were substances which by their nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its welfare. In both cases, the scientific evidence was that cocaine had passed through the two dogs TARGET CHRIS and PEPE BANANAS and concentrations reported indicated a window of exposure in the previous 48 hours or less (depending on the dose) before the samples were collected.

The Committee noted the reference dated 16 December 2019 provided by Mr Pat Buckley, a trainer and breeder in Ireland. In this letter, Mr Buckley explained that he had hoped to be at the Inquiry but due to family illness was unable to attend. The Committee noted that Mr Buckley had taken in Mr Dawson in August 2019 on condition that there would be no tolerance of any drug abuse. He stated that Mr Dawson was now drug free and was much more stable mentally and physically. Mr Buckley had applied to the IGB so that Mr Dawson could handle Mr Buckley's

Mr McTaggart commented that he had known Mr Dawson for many years. After he first got a licence in 2010 he had been enthusiastic and successful with a large kennel and had some notable winners. He became attached to Newcastle Stadium in 2012. His father had died in 2013 and by 2015 it was apparent that Mr Dawson went less to the track and the standard of care and condition of the greyhounds was less good, although Mr McTaggart said that he had had no welfare concerns.

The Committee considered the abuse of cocaine in greyhound racing as a grave issue. Cocaine was a highly restricted Class A Schedule 2 Controlled Drug and the Committee fully endorsed the views expressed by Mr Gibson that there can be no place for cocaine in greyhound racing. The Committee noted that Mr Dawson had relinquished his licence, appeared to be currently clear of his addiction and was endeavouring with the help of Mr Buckley to start a new life in Ireland. He had expressed

regret and contrition and the Committee accepted that Mr Dawson had not given cocaine to the dogs to affect their performance, although by his own admission his addiction may have affected his training and preparation of the greyhounds. The Committee noted that in the case of TARGET CHRIS Mr Dawson had attempted to place the blame on others and it was only after the Local Inquiry had taken place that he had confessed to his addiction. It was recorded that he had a previous conviction in 2012 when the greyhound TARGET MYSTERY had tested positive for a metabolite of cocaine.

In the circumstances of the two cases, the Disciplinary Committee ordered that on each count Mr Dawson be fined £1500 (a total of £3000) and be disqualified indefinitely.

2 Shawfield Stadium - DUDLEYS FOREVER Professional Trainer Mr C Sillars

Professional Trainer Chris Sillars was found in breach of rules 2, 152 (i) and (ii), and 174 (xi) of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that every person shall have full regard to Greyhound welfare and shall accept provisions of the Animal Welfare Act 2006, to ensure that the needs of a greyhound for which they are responsible are met to the extent required by good practice.

Mr Sillars was not in attendance. Daniel Rankin, racing manager of Shawfield Stadium, apologised for his non-attendance. Alex McTaggart, Stipendiary Steward, was present.

On behalf of GRB, Mr Gibson advised that Mr Sillars had relinquished his licence in a letter dated 31 August 2019 but stamped as received by GBGB on 5 September 2019. Mr McTaggart reported that he had made several efforts to find a date for a Local Inquiry but on each occasion Mr Sillars was unable to attend. Mr Sillars then prepared a Statement and agreed that the Local Inquiry should be held without him: this took place at Shawfield Stadium on 9th September 2019 in the presence of the Racing Manager, Mr Daniel Rankin.

Mr McTaggart gave evidence that he had made a routine visit to Mr Sillars' kennels on 2 September 2019 at 1345. There was no reply, but the kennels were not secured so Mr McTaggart gained access. He reported that the GBGB kennel block had contained nine greyhounds and there was a further greyhound in a Chicube kennel. There were four other greyhounds in another non-registered block that had been previously deemed unusable by Mr McTaggart. One of these dogs, DUDLEYS FOREVER, a black bitch that had last raced at Shawfield on 24 November 2018, was in such poor condition that Mr McTaggart described it as 'the worst condition of a greyhound I have seen'. Video evidence was presented to the Committee. Mr McTaggart said that in his opinion this was a matter of animal cruelty.

Mr McTaggart said that on the same afternoon as his visit he had spoken by telephone to Mr Sillars who had informed him that **DUDLEYS FOREVER was eating** well, and had been to the vet two months previously. Mr McTaggart told Mr Sillars that the bitch needed to see a vet as a matter of urgency. Mr Sillars complied and took the greyhound to Abbey Vet Group later that day. The veterinary report was given in evidence and stated that the bitch weighed 16.3 kg with a body condition score of 1/5. Further tests were not undertaken, and the bitch was euthanased.

The following day, Mr McTaggart met Mr Sillars who accepted that it was not true that DUDLEYS FOREVER had been seen by a vet recently. It was on 2 December 2018 (i.e. ten months previously) when, according to the Treatment Book, she had been treated for 'an infection'. Mr Sillars told Mr McTaggart that the bitch had started losing weight in May 2019, but continued to eat well; he said he did not wish to take her to the vet as he thought she would 'just be put to sleep'. He accepted in his Statement that he should have taken her sooner to the vet.

Mr McTaggart said that on his 2 September 2019 visit, the other greyhounds in the kennels were in good enough condition, but there were no water bowls in the kennels and four greyhounds were housed in the block he considered unusable.

Mr McTaggart advised the Committee that Mr Sillars had only held a PT licence since the death in November 2018 of his mother, former trainer Betty Sillars, for whom Mr Sillars had been kennelhand from 1989 to 2018. He said that under Mrs Sillars, the priority had always been the dogs.

The Committee took the view that this was a clear case of animal abuse. The distressing video clip endorsed the opinion of a highly experienced Stipendiary Steward that this was the worst condition of a greyhound he had ever seen, and the Committee concurred. When presented to the veterinary surgeon, DUDLEYS FOREVER weighed only 16.3kg (against a racing weight of 24-26kg). The Committee deplored the neglect of this greyhound and concluded that Mr Sillars had treated the greyhound with cruelty and in such a manner as to cause the greyhound unnecessary suffering. The deliberate decision of Mr Sillars not to seek veterinary attention was wholly unacceptable. The Committee considered the offence to be a prima facie breach of the Animal Health and Welfare (Scotland) Act 2006 and urged the GBGB to send the details of the case to the Crown Office & Procurator Fiscal Service in Edinburgh.

In the circumstances of the case, the Committee ordered that Mr Sillars be warned off indefinitely.

The Disciplinary Committee of the GBGB were in attendance at a meeting held on 19 December 2019:-Mr R Woodworth CBE (in the chair) Mr A Hunt

1 Monmore Green Stadium – FITENWELL – Professional Trainer Mrs Emma Richards

Mr H Starte

Professional Trainer Mrs Emma Richards was found in breach of rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound FITENWELL at Monmore Green Stadium on 10 August 2019 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of ranitidine, and that she had in her charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing.

Mrs Richards apologised that she could neither be present or available by telephone because of a hospital appointment. Tony Williamson, racing manager of Monmore Green Stadium also apologised for his nonattendance. Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, and Pete Rosney, area stipendiary steward, were in attendance.

The Committee heard evidence from stipendiary steward Pete Rosney that

FITENWELL (which was a top-class greyhound) had provided a positive sample taken randomly pre-race at Monmore Green Stadium when the dog had won its second graded race in a good time. The dog had gone on to win a number of Open Races. Professor Morris gave evidence that ranitidine is not available as a veterinary medicine for use in dogs but its use in horses when prescribed under the prescribing cascade by a veterinarian is not uncommon. It is used in humans to reduce stomach acid. It would only indirectly affect the performance of a greyhound that suffered from gastritis by the alleviation of symptoms, but Mrs Richards had given evidence that she had not administered ranitidine nor had the dog got gastritis. The Committee received a statement from FITENWELL's owner that he had taken Zantac (one of the trade names for ranitidine) some years ago but did not regard this as relevant to the case. There was no evidence that ranitidine could have resulted from the reported feeding regime used by Mrs Richards but the Committee noted the lack of traceability of the meat used.

On the balance of probabilities, the Committee concluded that the ranitidine came from contaminated meat fed by Mrs Richards to her charges. Her supplier had promised, after being contacted by Mrs Richards regarding the positive, to supply receipts confirming that the meat was "outdated meat fit for human consumption" but no receipts had been forthcoming. The Committee concluded that Mrs Richards had been casual, perhaps deliberately so, in purchasing meat which in all possibility was category 2 and therefore taken a chance that her charges might give a positive sample. The board has published a number of reminders about the risk of using category 2 ABPs for racing greyhounds.

The Committee accepted the Director of Regulation's submission and determined that Mrs Richards (who had an unblemished record) should be cautioned and fined £400.

2 Sheffield Stadium – GARNAMAN – Professional Trainer Mr Gary Griffiths

Professional Trainer Mr Gary Griffiths was found in breach of rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound GARNAMAN at Sheffield Stadium

on 2 July 2019 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of norethisterone and that he had in his charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing.

Mr Griffiths apologised for not being in attendance. Richard Munton, racing manager of Sheffield Stadium, also apologised for his nonattendance. Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, and Pete Rosney, area stipendiary steward, were in attendance.

Professor Morris gave evidence that norethisterone is a widely used oestrus suppressant for female greyhounds but that when given to male dogs it had the potential to produce adverse female sex steroid effects. It could therefore affect the performance of a greyhound or could prejudice its wellbeing.

Professor Morris evidence confirmed the strong possibility in this case that the dog GARNAMAN had produced a positive sample for norethisterone as a result of it eating a norethisterone tablet contained in the feed of its kennel companion JUST KATY but discarded by the latter or alternatively as a result of Mr Griffiths mistakenly swapping the feeding for GARNAMAN with that of JUST KATY whose feed contained the norethisterone tablet.

The Committee was concerned about the circumstances in which Mr Griffiths kennelhand had supplied to Mr Griffiths a large number of norethisterone tablets at the time JUST KATY had been transferred from the kennels of its late trainer especially as the tablet container was unlabelled. However, the Committee concluded that there was no intention on Mr Griffiths part to affect the outcome of the race in which GARNAMAN was competing and that the positive resulted accidentally from his feeding practice which had allowed this to occur. Mr Griffiths stated that he had changed his practice to ensure there would be no further occurrences.

The Committee cautioned Mr Griffiths and fined him £200.

3 Doncaster Stadium - MINTBET CHIEF Professional Trainer Miss Kelly Tobin

Professional Trainer Miss Kelly Tobin was found in breach of rules 174 (i) (b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of

Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound MINTBET CHIEF at Doncaster Stadium on 1 May 2019 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of dehydroxylated metabolite of stanozolol, and that she had in her charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing.

Miss Tobin was present by telephone with partner Mick Foley, who provided answers to the committee. Simon Pearson, racing manager of Doncaster Stadium, apologised for his non-attendance. Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, and Pete Rosney, area stipendiary steward, were in attendance.

Evidence was given that MINTBET CHIEF came into Miss Tobin's kennel on 22 November 2018 and gave a Point of Registration sample on the 17th December 2018 having previously had 2 testicles surgically removed on the 11th December 2018. Professor Morris stated that while the P.O.R sample had initially appeared to be negative, on re-examination of the data in August 2019 (after the positive race sample for stanozolol) it was concluded by LGC that the screening tests indicated the possible presence of metabolites of stanozolol. These were at low levels which suggested an administration some 6-12 months before the dog came into Miss Tobin's care. Had the stanozolol been administered in the UK before the POR sample the positive signal in the LGC tests would have been considerably stronger. The removal of the testicles might have provided a natural and temporary boost to any stanozolol in the dog's system. Professor Morris stated that stanozolol, as an anabolic steroid is not available as a veterinary medicine in the UK or Ireland. It affects dogs as it does other animals and people by building muscle. However anabolic steroids have many serious side effects which could by their nature affect the performance of a greyhound or could prejudice its wellbeina.

The Committee heard evidence of the several Irish hands through whom MINTBET CHIEF had passed before being sold on to Miss Tobin and also heard that her partner Mick Foley had specifically asked the vendor William Foley from whom he had satisfactorily purchased greyhounds before whether a named Irish vendor

(with whom he had had a previous adverse experience) was involved in the dog's ownership and had been assured, wrongly, that he wasn't.

The Committee concluded that on the balance of probabilities Miss Tobin and Mr Foley would have been unaware that MINTBET CHIEF had stanozolol in its system when they purchased it and that they had taken reasonable measures to assure that the dog was not under suspicion having previously dealt with the vendor.

While Miss Tobin accepted that she had technically been in breach of rules 174 (i) (b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing the Committee decided to follow the submission of the Director of Regulation and take no further action.

4 Swindon Stadium - BALLYHALE ERIC Greyhound Trainer Mr Shaun Chappell

Greyhound Trainer Mr Shaun Chappell was found in breach of rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound BALLYHALE ERIC at Swindon Stadium on 14 May 2019 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of pholcodine, and that he had in his charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing.

Greyhound Trainer Mr Shaun Chappell had apologised for his non-attendance on health grounds but had authorised his father Mr W. ("Billy") Chappell to attend the inquiry on his behalf by telephone. Mr Clive Oseman, racing manager of Swindon Stadium, apologised for his non-attendance. Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, was in attendance. Meriel France, area stipendiary steward, was also in attendance by telephone.

Professor Morris gave evidence that pholcodine is not available as a veterinary medicine but is widely used in a number of cough suppressants used in humans. It is a substance which by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or by its other effects prejudice the greyhound's wellbeing. The Treatment Book and statement described the use by Billy Chappell of a "cough medicine" obtained from Boots chemists and Professor

Morris concluded that the pholocodine positive was consistent with the greyhound having been given a "human" cough medicine.

The Committee heard evidence that BALLYHALE ERIC had had a long-standing condition which it transpired had been caused by lungworm, which was only finally resolved a month after giving a positive sample in a trial at Swindon. During this period Billy Chappell stated that the dog usually had not shown signs of a kennel cough but particularly in the mornings had a regular nasal discharge and made unusual snorting sounds. He also stated that he had seen Simon Gower 3 times with the dog whether at Mr Gower's surgery or at Swindon Stadium (where Mr Gower provides veterinary services). However, Mr Gower's statement suggested that he had seen BALLYHALE ERIC only once, after the positive sample, when lungworm had been diagnosed and successfully treated. Billy Chappell admitted administering a medicine to BALLYHALE ERIC in the interests, as he put it, of the animal's welfare, which he said had been the remnants of a cough medicine used by his wife. It was unclear whether this medicine had been or was in addition to what Billy Chappell recorded in the kennel treatment book as a honey-based herbal preparation. Professor Morris confirmed that many human cough medicines contained pholcodine, but that the herbal product would not. The Committee concluded that the licensed greyhound Trainer Mr Shaun Chappell would have been aware of his father's frustration at the difficulty of restoring BALLYHALE ERIC to good health and would have acquiesced in the use of a human medicine. In any event the medicine was not prescribed by a veterinarian and both Shaun and Billy Chappell would have been fully aware that the trailing or racing of a greyhound in these circumstances is strictly prohibited.

The Committee concluded that there had been no intention on Shaun or Billy Chappell's part to affect the outcome of a trial or race but nevertheless cautioned Mr Shaun Chappell and fined him the sum of £300.

LOCAL INQUIRIES

Monmore Green Stadium – DRAGONFLY

At a local inquiry held by the Area Stipendiary Steward on 11 November 2019, professional trainer Mr B McBride was cautioned for a breach of Rule 49(iv) in respect of the improved performance of the greyhound DRAGONFLY at Monmore Green Stadium on 14 August 2019; and his failure to use his best endeavours to ensure that the performance of the greyhound was to the satisfaction of the Stewards.

Opening at 7/4 and starting at 9/4, the greyhound had won a 480m race recording a calculated time of 28.92 seconds as compared with its best recent time of 29.54 seconds recorded in a trial on 19 July 2019.

2 Monmore Green Stadium – JOE MONTANA

At a local inquiry held by the Area Stipendiary Steward on 11 November 2019, professional trainer Mr B McBride was cautioned for a breach of Rule 49(iv) in respect of the improved performance of the greyhound JOE MONTANA at Monmore Green Stadium on 17 October 2019; and his failure to use his best endeavours to ensure that the performance of the greyhound was to the satisfaction of the Stewards

Opening at 7/2 and starting at 4/1, the greyhound had won a 480m race recording a calculated time of 28.76 seconds as compared with its best recent time of 29.41 seconds recorded in a race on 11 October 2019.

3 Peterborough Stadium – ARDERA NIAMH

At a local inquiry held by the Area Stipendiary Steward on 18 December 2019, professional trainer Miss S Spillane's explanation was accepted in respect of the improved performance of the greyhound ARDERA NIAMH at Peterborough Stadium on 31 August 2019.

Opening at 7/4 and starting at 2/1F, the greyhound had won a 435m race recording a calculated time of 26.63 seconds as compared with its best recent time of 27.25 seconds recorded in a trial on 23 August 2019.

4 Peterborough Stadium - PENNYS WRIGHT

At a local inquiry held by the Area Stipendiary Steward on 18 December 2019, professional trainer Mr P Braithwaite's explanation was accepted in respect of the improved performance of the greyhound PENNYS WRIGHT at Peterborough Stadium on 19 April 2019.

Starting at 2/1F, the greyhound had won a 435m race recording a calculated time of 26.20 seconds as compared with its best recent time of 26.97 seconds recorded in a race on 23 March 2019.
