**COUNT ONE**  
**ILLEGAL VOTING**  
W.Va. Code §3-9-17

That TESS ALAYNA BISHOP, on or about June 11, 2019, in Jefferson County, West Virginia, while being a resident of the State of Utah, residing in the State of Utah, and registered to vote in Utah, did unlawfully and knowingly vote in the Harpers Ferry municipal election when not legally entitled to do so because she did not reside in Harpers Ferry and she was not a bona fide resident of West Virginia in violation of Chapter 3, Article 9, Section 17 of the Code of West Virginia, as amended, against the peace and dignity of the State.
