

Make Nanogirl's windmill

INGREDIENTS

A square piece of paper Scissors A popsicle stick or an old straw Glue Blu-tack A thumb tack

METHOD

Take your square piece of paper and decorate it however you like. Then fold it in half so the corners touch to make a triangle. Now fold it the opposite way to make the other corners touch.

Cut down your creases, but not all the way to the middle. Leave about 1cm space.

Then fold down one of the cut corners and glue it to the middle. Repeat this with all four corners. You might need to wait a while for the glue to dry.

Attach the blades you've made to the popsicle stick or straw, with the thumb tack through the middle of the paper. Make sure there's a little space between the paper and the straw.

Now blow into the blades and watch it spin.
