**NARRATIVE**

On Friday, 10-23-2015 at approximately 1720 hours, I responded to 4636 26 Street in reference to an exhibition of a weapon. Prior to my arrival, the caller informed Communications that the suspect, Debbie Cooney, had left the residence in her red, two door Hyundai.

Upon my arrival I met with the victim, Cynthia Little. She was very upset and visibly shaking. It took a few minutes to gain information from her. During my interview, she had to be brought back on track with her statements several times due to her being so upset and scared. Cynthia moved into the residence on September 29, 2015 with her boyfriend. They were renting a room from Cooney.

Cynthia stated that she and her boyfriend, Michael Hnatusko, were having dinner. Michael went out to work on his pick up truck. Cooney came home and a verbal argument occurred between Cynthia and Cooney. The argument was due to previous financial agreements between the three of them. Cooney demanded that Cynthia and Michael move out. Cynthia stated that Cooney pulled out gun from her purse and pointed it directly at her face. Cynthia started yelling that Cooney had a gun and Michael came into the house.

I spoke to Michael. He stated that while he was working on the truck, he heard Cynthia yelling about a gun. He came into the house and saw Cooney pointing an old revolver, black in color, at Cynthia. He attempted to calm the situation by saying they would move out. Cooney left the kitchen and went into the laundry room before leaving the residence in her red, two door Hyundai. Michael was not sure what Cooney did with the gun.

I spoke to another roommate that was home during the incident, Tien Nguyen. He stated that he was in his room and did not hear or see anything.

I gained permission to search the laundry room as it is community usage for the household from Cynthia. No weapon was located in the laundry room.
