Office of Community & Civic Life limiting walk-in hours during State of Emergency

To limit the risks to public health during the City of Portland's COVID-19 State of Emergency, the Office of Community & Civic Life is restricting walk-in hours at the City Hall location.

The front desk at the Office of Community & Civic Life in City Hall, Room 110 will be open to the public on Monday and Wednesday from 9am to 1pm and by appointment only.

The public is encouraged to use mail, email, or phone calls to contact the appropriate program.

Details for specific programs:

- Liquor Licensing: Submit all applications for annual, renewal, or temporary liquor licenses through the mail. Applications can be found on the <u>OLCC website</u> and mailed to 1221 SW 4th Ave, Room 110, Portland, OR, 97204. Renewal payments can be made <u>online</u>. For questions, call 503-823-4520.
- Noise: Submit all applications for noise variances online and noise complaints online.

If it is necessary to deliver applications in-person to City Hall, people are encouraged to wash their hands upon entering the building before delivering any paperwork.
