Hi Bill,

I apologize for the delay. The number of people who have tested positive after April 9 have reported they voted in person or worked the polls on election day: **61** – we are not including anyone whose symptom onset began after 4/21, as this would likely not have been the exposure.

Contact tracers do ask if patients attended mass gatherings, but not specifically about protests, so there's really no data on who may have contracted COVID-19 at a protest.
