O R D E R

The Court, by a panel consisting of Chief Justice Brutinel, Justice Bolick, Justice Gould, and Justice Montgomery, has considered the briefs of the parties, the record, the trial court's ruling, and the relevant statutes and case law in this expedited election matter.

The Court finds that the circulator's civil rights had been restored pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-907 such that the circulator was eligible to circulate petitions. A.R.S. § 16-321(D). Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED affirming the trial court decision.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors and County Recorder shall leave Michelle Robertson's name on the ballot for mayor for the City of Glendale, for the primary election of August 4, 2020.
