To: Judge Matthew B. Shirtcliff:

On May 23, 2020, the Oregon Supreme Court allowed relators' petition for an alternative writ of mandamus.

By this reference, all well-pleaded allegations in the petition are incorporated in this Writ as if set out in full.

Wherefore, in the name of the State of Oregon, you are commanded to either (1) vacate your May 18, 2020, "Order Granting Preliminary Injunctive Relief and Denying Motion to Dismiss," to the extent that it grants plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunctive relief, and to issue an order denying plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunctive relief, or, in the alternative, (2) show cause for not doing so, no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 26, 2020.

If this court does not receive notice of compliance with the alternative writ of mandamus by the court to which the writ was directed, the relators shall file their opening brief no later than Thursday, May 28, 2020, notwithstanding ORAP 11.15(1)(a). The adverse parties shall file their answering briefs, if any, no later than Tuesday, June 2, 2020, notwithstanding ORAP 11.15(2). In lieu of an answering brief, an adverse party may file a notice with the court that it intends to rely on the memorandum that it filed opposing the petition; any such notice shall be filed no later than Tuesday, June 2, 2020.

On May 22, 2020, the court granted an application to appear as amicus curiae filed by the Oregon Nurses Association, in support of the relator's petition for mandamus, and the court accepted the accompanying brief. If the Oregon Nurses Association wishes to file an additional brief on the merits, it shall file that brief no later than Thursday, May 28, 2020.

The trial court or judge is not a party to the mandamus proceeding, ORS 34.250(2), although the court or judge may seek to intervene, ORS 34.250(4).
