






Americans Say the Coronavirus is Getting Worse




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
Sharp Decline in GOP Satisfaction with the Way Things are Going in the Country Today



Overwhelming Number of Americans Believe that the Country is on The Wrong Track




Trump's Job Approval Ratings have Remained Largely Unchanged Since Taking Office



Trump's Declining Job Overall Ratings Align Closely to his Handling of COVID-19




Job Approval in First Term for Presidents Since 1980





Biden Currently has a Decisive Lead in Electoral College Voting






