UA is requesting recommendations for renaming six buildings on campus. These are the suggestions of your local union, UCW-AL (3965), based on the work of Dr. Hilary Green.

B.B. COMER HALL *BECOMES*
VIVIAN MALONE JONES HALL

JONES was the first Black student to graduate from UA in 1965.

BIBB GRAVES HALL *BECOMES*
AUTHERINE LUCY FOSTER HALL

FOSTER was the first Black student to enroll at UA in 1956 and was instrumental in its desegregation.

MANLY HALL *BECOMES*
A TRIBUTE TO THOSE ENSLAVED
ON UA'S CAMPUS

The enslaved people who labored under Manly's administration deserve recognition.

MORGAN HALL *BECOMES*
ZORA NEALE HURSTON HALL

Born in Notasulga, AL, HURSTON was a chronicler of southern African American oral traditions.

MOORE HALL *BECOMES*
JEREMIAH BARNES HALL

BARNES was enslaved at UA and later became Superintendent of Colored Schools in Tuscaloosa.

NOTT HALL *BECOMES*
WAGER SWAYNE HALL

SWAYNE was a Freedmen's Bureau agent who advanced Black education throughout AL.
