


## A unique online election simulation game, custom-tailored for your group.

With new technological innovations emerging all the time, what will the next wave of disinformation look like, and how will it impact the 2020 election?

Threatcast 2020 is a live online election simulation that lets your group brainstorm real answers to this question in a fun, fast-paced game played on a customized digital platform. Players join teams representing political factions and agents of chaos, competing to achieve their goals with deviously creative uses of technology and the internet through a series of rounds charting the 2020 race.



- Explore the possibilities for the next wave of political disinformation
- Anticipate how groups with vastly different agendas might interact in the 2020 election
- Uncover brand new ways that technology can be used (and abused) for political goals
- Be prepared for our uncertain political future in 2020 and beyond

After the game, we'll lead the group in a discussion about the most interesting ideas that emerged from play, and compile a summary document for all participants.
