MOTION TO REVOKE DEFENDANT'S BOND

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

COMES NOW THE STATE OF TEXAS, by and through the undersigned Assistant District Attorney of Harris County, Texas, and moves the Court, pursuant to the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, to revoke Defendant's bond in the above Cause Number for the following reasons:

I.

The Defendant was released on \$100,000 in Cause No. 165221801010 for CAPITAL MURDER on OCTOBER 31, 2019. According to a bond violation report from pretrial that was submitted August 17, 2020, this defendant was placed under the supervision of Pretrial on June 26, 2020. Since then, he's failed to report to Pretrial, he's failed to comply with Pretrial's request to tender over verification he tested positive for COVID-19, and he's failed to abide by the Court's order to have a GPS ankle monitor.

This defendant is on bond for Capital Murder among four other felonies and two misdemeanors. He was ordered by this Court to have an ankle monitor as a condition of his bond.


The defendant has gone nearly two months while on bond without a GPS ankle monitor - a condition this Court found necessary for this defendant while on bond, facing very serious allegations.

This defendant has demonstrated a blatant and continuous history of disregarding Court orders with regard to conditions of bond. This defendant is a threat to the community and the State is requesting his bond be revoked for his non-compliance.

II.

The State hereby respectfully urges the court to grant the State's Motion to Revoke Defendant's Bond.
