I responded and was told by Whaley that he saw him, knows his identity, and yelled for him to stop, but he fled into the woods. He showed me the entrance into a briar thicket where he fled. He told me he could hear him walking in the woods up until I arrived.											
I walked to the edge of the road and yelled the K9 Command several times ("To the person in the woods, I am about to send the dog. He will find you and you will be bit."), but he never answered. Due to the thickness of the briars I knew I would be unable to work him on lead, so I

sent him off lead to search. He searched for several minutes and I could tell he picked up the scent. At one point I heard Andrews yell and I noticed Andor heard this. I told Andor to search and apprehend and he took off in that direction. At this point I lost contact with Andor.

I went out to the road, crossed back into the woods, traveled into the woods approximately 200 yards and cut back towards the original wooded area, laying a track for Andor to find me.

Approximately 20 minutes from the time I lost contact with him I heard him coming toward me through the woods. I called to him and he made contact with me.

When I first saw him I noticed that his mouth had a large amount of blood in it. This leads me to now believe that Andor bit him somewhere about the body. I then noticed that he was injured. I observed at least two wounds to his face area. I also noticed what appeared to be a stab wound on his back, approximately 18 inches from the top of his head.

I advised Sgt. Pettus that Andor was injured and to have the paramedics enroute. I then advised dispatch to call Lincoln Vet Clinic and have them on standby. I worked my way to my patrol car with Andor and upon further inspection noticed that he would need medical attention. Dispatch then called and had Dr. Hillman respond.

NARRATIVE

I took Andor to Lincoln Vet Clinic and met with Dr. Hillman. He drugged Andor so that he could operate. He first shaved the hair around the wounds and then began working on his back wound. He stuck a probe into the wound and found it to be approximately 2-4 inches deep. He then sewed it up. He moved to his head and did the same on the wound above his right eyebrow. The probe went in approximately 2 inches. He said he does not believe the knife or cutting instrument struck anything major on either stab wound. There was also a slash wound on his left ear. All were sewn up.

I will follow up in the next few days for further examination.

NARRATIVE

On 03/24/2015, while in shift formation, Officer Hamm came in and informed us that he had been told that Frank Andrews, a known Sex Offender, had been lying in the woodline near 101 Grogan Road in Talladega, AL. Andrews had warrants through Talladega County and Calhoun County. Around 21:50hrs, I was patrolling on Grogan Road. When I neared the area of 101, I turned on my left alley light and noticed the individual I know as Frank Andrews, lying in the woodline about 20 feet from the side of the road. I stopped and yelled at him to come out of the woods. He stood up and took a step toward me. He was wearing a white and dark striped shirt. When I got out of the patrol unit I yelled, "Come on out Frank!". He yelled something back and started out toward a trail to the left of where he was lying. I yelled to him several times after that telling him to come out of the woods. I then called K9 Officer Chesser and asked if he could assist. Officer Chesser came up

NARRATIVE	and asked where he went in the woods at. I showed him and Chesser yelled for Andrews to come out that he was going to deploy the K9. Officer Chesser and K9 Andor went into the woods where I had observed Andrews lying. A short time later I heard a loud yell from the woods. Shortly after that Officer Chesser came over the radio and stated that he could not find Andor. I stayed at the side of the road in case Andor or Andrews came out of the woods. Chesser stated that Andor was hurt. He had been cut. Chesser then took Andor away from the scene. A parameter was set up per Sgt. Pettus. Oxford officers arrived and then Sgt Pettus sent me to meet St Clair County's K9 Officers on the Square. They followed me to Grogan Road and deployed their dogs. Andrews was not located at that time.
