1. The Quality Assurance Program (QAP), National Center for Credibility Assessment, recently conducted an inspection of the U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Office of Internal Affairs (CBP OIA) polygraph program. The inspection report is enclosed.
2. The CBP OIA polygraph program was found to comply with their policies and procedures and met or exceeded the standards required of a federal government polygraph program. During the QAP inspection, 118 criteria in nine primary areas were inspected. No recommendations were made regarding the criteria.
